



If you are taking any of the following medications, they will need to be held for minimum of 7 days prior to your procedure or your procedure may be cancelled.

Diabetes/Weight Loss drugs in the GLP-1 agonists class are generally taken by a shot (injection) given daily or weekly and include:

- Dulaglutide (Trulicity)
- Exenatide extended release (Bydureon bcise)
- Exenatide (Byetta)
- Semaglutide (Ozempic, Rybelsus, Weygovy)
- Liraglutide (Victoza, Saxenda)
- Lixisenatide (Adlyxin)
- Tirzepatide (Mounjaro, Zepbound)

Diabetes medicines in the SGLT2 inhibitor class are generally taken daily include:

- Brenzavvy™ (bexagliflozin)
- Invokana® (canagliflozin)
- Farxiga® (dapagliflozin)
- Jardiance® (empagliflozin)
- Steglatro® (ertugliflozin)
- Suglat (ipragliflozin)
- Xigduo (dapagliflozin and metformin)
- Glyxambi (empagliflozin and linagliptin)
